## \*HAF Funding Available 14th - 17th April & 22nd - 25th April

#### What is HAF funding?

Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) is a programme specifically targeted to offer free holiday activities to Primary school aged children who are eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals. The aim is that the children who attend the provision will eat more healthily over the school holidays; be more active during the school holidays; take part in engaging and enriching activities; to be safe and not to be socially isolated; to have greater knowledge of health and nutrition; and to be more engaged with school and other local services.

Families with a County postcode must obtain a HAF code in order to book.









All school aged children from reception to Year 11, in receipt of <u>benefits related free school</u> <u>meals</u> are eligible for:

- up to 4 free HAF sessions over the Easter and Christmas holidays, and
- up to 16 free HAF sessions over the summer holidays

To make it easier for families to access their free HAF places this Easter, we will be working with schools to issue Holiday Activities e-vouchers directly to parents/carers of eligible children.
